

Rock Fishing

Currarong lies within the Jervis Bay Marine Park and fishing is not allowed in Sanctuary Zones. However a large proportion of the coastline is accessible for rock fishing.

Over the years rock fishing has consistently returned fabulous catches for many anglers.

One of the best known rock ledges on the South Coast is Beecroft Head. From this rock platform large numbers of kingfish, sharks, tuna, luderick, black drummer and snapper have been landed.
